INGREDIENTS

Vitamin A	10,000iu/ml	
Vitamin D	5,000 iu/ml

DIRECTIONS

Sheep

Pour 1 litre RPM® concentrate in a 5 L pack, top up with water to make 5 L. Shake to mix well. Do not exceed maximum dosage of 1ml concentrate per 10kg bodyweight. Dose ewes pre-tup and pre-lambing, and lamb at docking and drenching.

Cattle:

Dilute one part RPM° concentrate with one part water giving a 1:1 solution. Shake well. Dose once a month.

DOSAGE

Diluted1:4 solution:

• Lambs: 5mL

• Hoggets: 8mL

• Ewes: 10mL

Diluted 1:1 solution:

• Calves: 5mL

Heifers: 10mLCows: 20mL

CARE

Care should be taken to avoid over supplementation from this product and/ or concurrent use of other products containing selenium. The user can consult their veterinarian to determine an animal's selenium status.

WITHHOLDING PERIODS

Milk and Meat: Nil

STORAGE

Store below 30°C in the original container. Once open must be used in 1 month.
